

**INTERSTATE 35 COMMUNITY SCHOOL DISTRICT**  
**BOARD OF EDUCATION MEETING MINUTES**

April 10, 2017

The Interstate 35 Community School District Board of Education held a special meeting, Monday, April 10, 2017, at 7:00 p.m. in the High School Library in Truro, Iowa.

President Bryan Arzani called the meeting to order at 7:01 p.m. Directors Bryan Arzani, Josh Hughes, Dan Kirkpatrick, Jeremy Maske, and Eddie Vonnahme were in attendance. Also present were Superintendent Dr. Kevin Fiene and Board Secretary Ted Bauer. All in attendance recited the Pledge of Allegiance.

Motion by Kirkpatrick, seconded by Hughes to approve the agenda; motion carried 5-0.

At 7:02 p.m., Arzani declared the public hearing for the FY18 school budget open.

Arzani noted that no member of the public was in attendance. At 7:03 p.m., Motion by Hughes, seconded by Vonnahme to close the public hearing; motion carried 5-0. Arzani declared the public hearing closed.

Hughes moved to approve and adopt the FY2018 budget as published at \$18.77356 (per \$1,000 taxable valuation) and direct the Board Secretary to certify the FY2018 budget by April 17; when the Iowa Department issues the draft Aid and Levy Worksheet and Tax Rates in May, the Board Secretary is directed to lower the overall tax rate to \$18.67356 (or as close as possible) which is the FY 2017 overall tax rate, seconded by Vonnahme; motion carried 5-0.

At 7:05 p.m., Arzani declared the public hearing for the 2017-2018 School Calendar open.

Superintendent Dr. Fiene presented the proposed 2017-2018 School Calendar. Fiene explained that it is very similar to the 2016-2017 School Calendar.

Arzani noted that no member of the public was in attendance. Motion by Hughes, seconded by Vonnahme to close the public hearing; motion carried 5-0. Arzani declared the public hearing closed.

The graduation date and time for 2017-2018 was discussed. Fiene recommended that the calendar be approved as presented and if a change is needed to the graduation date and time, the calendar can be amended. Motion by Hughes, seconded by Kirkpatrick to approve the 2017-2018 School Calendar as presented; motion carried 5-0.

At 7:10 p.m., motion by Hughes, seconded by Kirkpatrick to adjourn; motion carried 5-0.
