

INTERSTATE 35 COMMUNITY SCHOOL DISTRICT
SPECIAL BOARD MEETING MINUTES

September 24, 2016

The Interstate 35 Community School District Board of Education met in special session, Saturday, September 24, 2016, at 8:00 a.m. in the High School Library in Truro, Iowa.

President Bryan Arzani called the meeting to order at 8:03 a.m. Directors Bryan Arzani, Josh Hughes, Dan Kirkpatrick, and Jeremy Maske were present. Director Eddie Vonnahme was absent. Also present were Superintendent Dr. Kevin Fiene, Secondary Principal Steve Kaster, Dean of Students Rose Dickinson, District Legal Counsel Danielle Haindfield, and Board Secretary Ted Bauer. All in attendance recited the Pledge of Allegiance.

At 8:04 a.m., Motion by Maske, seconded by Kirkpatrick, to move into closed session as authorized by Iowa Code Section 21.5(1)(a) & 21.5(1)(e) to review or discuss records which are required or authorized by state or federal law to be kept confidential and to conduct a hearing to determine whether to suspend or expel a student; roll call vote was taken, motion carried 4-0. The Board moved to an adjacent classroom for privacy.

At 9:20 a.m., the Board returned to open session and reconvened in the high school library. Motion by Hughes, seconded by Maske, that the Board accept the superintendent's recommendation that the student who was the subject of the disciplinary hearing be expelled from attendance in the Interstate 35 Community School District and any school activities for the remainder of the first semester of the 2016-2017 school year, unless permission is granted by the District administration, in accordance with the terms and conditions established by the Board and shall be allowed the resources and options during the expulsion period as recommended by the superintendent; that upon completion of the expulsion period, an application for re-admission must be submitted in-person and approved by the administration with a recommendation to the Board for approval prior to re-admission; and that written findings and conclusions consistent with the Board's deliberations will be prepared and the President is authorized and directed to execute the Findings of Facts and Conclusion; roll call vote was taken, motion carried 4-0.

Kirkpatrick moved to adjourn, Maske seconded; motion carried 4-0. Meeting was adjourned at 9:24 a.m.
