

Interstate 35 Quarterback Club Scholarship

The Interstate 35 Quarterback Club Scholarship is presented to a senior that was involved with the football program (player, manager, stat). The scholarship is funded by the QB Club and will be presented at senior awards night.

Eligibility: Must be a graduate of I-35 that has participated in the football program, as a player, manager, or stat.

The student will be judged on the following:

1. 10 points for full year of high school participation
2. A cumulative GPA from ninth to twelfth grades--times ten.
3. A written essay with a maximum of 50 points. The essay is to be on the subject of " How I think my participation in football has helped me prepare for my future".

The Scholarship will be given at the successful completion of one semester of college, trade school, or respective training. The money will be paid directly to the student. The student must show proof of completion of one semester.

Duties of the Judges are as follows:

1. The principal and guidance counselor will be the sole judges of the points awarded on grades. They will number the essays that so that the essay judges will see no names.
2. Three members of the Quarterback Club will judge the essays, along with both high school English teachers. Points will be awarded based on the essays potential to inspire others to participate in the football program.
