

The Lyla M. Lynch Scholarship

Lyla M. Lynch established a trust in which the proceeds are to be used to financially aid different organizations. One of the organizations is the I-35 School District. In her will, her wishes for the established trust were the following:

The recipients of said scholarships and the amounts and conditions of the scholarships shall be determined by the committee composed of the Superintendent of Interstate 35 Schools, the Principal of the Interstate 35 High School, and the President of the School Board of Interstate 35 School District, subject to the following guidelines:

1. The recipients shall be selected on the basis of financial need, scholarship abilities, and extracurricular activities.
2. The persons receiving the award must provide evidence of acceptable attendance and academic progress (2.0 G.P.A. or higher).
3. In the event of a student dropping out of school, does not provide evidence of satisfactory progress, or does not demonstrate satisfactory progress, the money will go back into the scholarship fund.
4. Applicants must have attended I-35 High School for at least four complete consecutive semesters including the first semester of their senior year.

Amount of Award Per Student

It is the intent of the committee to give as many scholarships as possible each year in \$1,000 increments.

Application Deadline

The deadline for applying is the **last Friday in April**.

How Students Obtain The Award

At the end of the first semester, the student will provide their college or vocational school transcript showing satisfactory attendance and at least a 2.0 G.P.A. to the Interstate 35 High School Guidance Office. When the school is satisfied the student is making satisfactory progress, money will be distributed to the student. Deadline for notifying the school will be May 1 of their 1st year of college. If the student does not submit notification of satisfactory progress by that time or discontinues attendance, they will forfeit the award.

Selection Criteria For Application

- G.P.A. pts-1 point for each grade point.
- Class rank-Valedictorian=6 pts, Top 5%=5 pts, 6-10%=4 pts, 11-15%=3 pts, 16-20%=2 pts, 21%-lower=1 pt.
- 1 pt for each verified school related extra-curricular activity. Verification can be obtained from the office. **Fill out the attached checklist.**
- Points for ACT scores-0-18=1 pt, 20-22=2 pts, 23-26=3 pts, 27-29=4 pts, 30 and above=5 pts. Verification must be obtained from the Guidance Office.
- Private university=3 pts, state university=2 pts, 2-year college or tech school=1 pt. Letters of acceptance must be used for verification.
