

The Richard A. Meints Memorial Scholarship

Introduction: This scholarship is given in memory of Richard A. Meints. Mr. Meints was a mathematics and physics teacher at Interstate 35 High School from 1974 until his death in 1993.

Qualifications: There will be no application. The student must be in the graduating senior class and meet the requirements to graduate. The student must have taken 5 years of sequential college math (Algebra 1, Algebra 2, Geometry, Elementary Analysis and Calculus) plus a year of Physics. If more than one student qualifies for this scholarship, the student with the highest grade point average in the above listed courses will be the recipient. This will include the semester grades for each of the courses listed above. The scholarship will be given only if a student meets the qualifications.

Scholarship Amount: The amount of the scholarship will be \$500. The scholarship will be given only if a student qualifies.

Disbursement of Scholarship Funds: The Interstate 35 CSD will disburse the check payable to the student and the institution the student plans to attend. The Interstate 35 CSD will write and mail the check prior to graduation. Payment for the individual student plaque, the engraving and purchase of the plaque listing all recipients will come from this scholarship fund. The Richard A. Meints Memorial Scholarship will exist as long as funds remain in the account

Award Presentation: The student will receive an individual plaque at the Annual High School Awards program. The first presentation will be given at graduation ceremonies 1995. A plaque with names of all recipients will be displayed in the gymnasium area. A member of the science or math department will present the award annually.
