

INTERSTATE 35 COMMUNITY SCHOOL DISTRICT
BOARD OF EDUCATION MEETING MINUTES

April 19, 2016

The Interstate 35 Community School District Board of Education held a work session meeting on Tuesday, April 19, at 6:00 p.m. in the High School Library in Truro, Iowa.

Vice-President Dan Kirkpatrick called the meeting to order at 6:05 p.m., followed by the Pledge of Allegiance. Directors Dan Kirkpatrick, Jeremy Maske, and Eddie Vonnahme were in attendance. President Bryan Arzani arrived at 6:12 p.m. and Josh Hughes arrived at 6:39 p.m. Also present were Superintendent Dr. Kevin Fiene, Board Secretary Ted Bauer, and OPN Architects, Jim Henry and Rick Seely.

Motion by Vonnahme, seconded by Maske to approve the agenda; motion carried 3-0.

Jim Henry and Rick Seely presented site plan options and cost estimates for the three projects from Phase 1, e.g., auditorium, bus/maintenance building, and CTE space/building. Also included in the discussion was potential phasing/order of the projects and cost difference with the various options. It was shared Phase 1 – site planning – is nearing completion. The Board will study the data presented; Ted will arrange an upcoming meeting with Piper Jaffray to discuss costs, funding options, etc. At some point, the Board will need to decide whether to pursue any, all, or none of the projects.

Motion by Vonnahme to adjourn, seconded by Maske; motion carried 5-0. Meeting was adjourned at 7:07 p.m.
