

INTERSTATE 35 COMMUNITY SCHOOL DISTRICT
BOARD OF EDUCATION WORK SESSION MINUTES

July 28, 2015

The Interstate 35 Community School District Board of Education held a work session, Tuesday, July 28, 2015 at 6:15 p.m. in the High School Library in Truro, Iowa.

President Julie Brownlee called the work session to order at 6:16 p.m. Directors Bryan Arzani, Tracy Bean, Julie Brownlee, and Leah Gray were in attendance. Director Dan Kirkpatrick was absent. Also present was Superintendent Dr. Kevin Fiene. Board Secretary Ted Bauer was absent.

Motion by Gray, seconded by Bean to approve the agenda; motion carried 4-0.

The Board members and all in attendance went to tour the entire facility to learn about future needs in the facility and to assess progress on summer projects. Rick Gray, Director of Buildings and Grounds, and Geoff Tessau, Director of Support Services, led the tour.

Fiene shared that he attended a Truro Walking Trail Project meeting on July 15. The intent of this project is to develop a walking trail from the city park, in front of the school, through the Little League Field, around the north edge of school property, back to the city park. Fiene expressed that the school district is supportive of the project, but explained that the district could not fully commit for the walking path because some of the land may be used for future construction.
