

**INTERSTATE 35 COMMUNITY SCHOOL DISTRICT**  
**BOARD OF EDUCATION MEETING MINUTES**

April 25, 2016

The Interstate 35 Community School District Board of Education held a public hearing for the 2016-2017 school calendar on Monday, April 25, 2016, at 6:00 p.m. in the High School Library in Truro, Iowa.

President Bryan Arzani called the public hearing to order at 6:00 p.m. Directors Bryan Arzani, Josh Hughes, Dan Kirkpatrick, and Jeremy Maske were in attendance. Eddie Vonnahme was absent. Also present were Superintendent Dr. Kevin Fiene and Board Secretary Ted Bauer.

Fiene explained through a PowerPoint presentation the process and driving philosophies used to develop the recommended 2016-17 school calendar. He explained that a calendar committee of volunteers from various work groups within the school had been organized to meet and develop priorities for the calendar. Priorities included larger chunks of time for professional development and maintaining shortened days or week when school begins. The first draft of the calendar was created and reviewed by staff; this led to six additional drafts being developed and revised by staff and vetted by community members. This continuous process has led to the calendar proposed for the 2016-17 school year.

Arzani opened the public hearing for public comment and asked if anyone from the public had any questions. No one from the public had any comments or questions.

At 6:06 p.m., Hughes motioned to adjourn the public hearing, seconded by Maske; motion carried 4-0. Arzani declared the public hearing closed.
